- Muscadet, Orgeuil, Louise Chereau Vices & Vertus, Loire Valley, France – *wild! Melon de Bourgogne. ♀vintner, 40 y.o. vines, sustainable, estate-bottled* 45
- Prosecco, Cuvée Beatrice, Ca Furlan, Veneto Italy – *Glera, lightly fruity, sustainably farmed, estate bottled, DOC classic* 11 / 33 
- Sauvignon Blanc Petillant, Otto's Constant Dream, Hunter's Estate, Marlborough, New Zealand 2021 – *naturally fermented in stainless steel and partially aged in French oak, nice and dry, effervescent grapefruit, citrus & tropical flavors, sustainably farmed, YUM!* 38
- Secco Rosé, Hillinger, Austria (187) – *flashy but rooted in tradition, Charmant method, strawberries, delicate & refreshing* 10 / 40 
- Champagne, Laurent Perrier, Champagne, France (375ml) – *the real deal by the glass (2 glasses!)* 45 
- Champagne, Pommery, Brut Royal, Champagne, France – *the real deal by the bottle* 84

- Albariño, Garzòn, Maldonado, Uruguay 2021 – *Fresh pear, lime, & citrus with lovely minerality* 40
- Toscana, O'Lilla!, Baracchi, Tuscany, Italy 2019 – *Chard/Viognier (80%/20%), bouquet of green apple, citrus, pineapple, with flowery notes and herbs; intense & fresh, estate-bottled* 41
- Chardonnay, Fess Parker, Santa Barbara County, California, 2022 – *aromas of stone fruit, lemon, minerals, flavors of apple, lemon, cream, thyme, aged in French oak, estate-grown* 40
- Chardonnay, Chalk Hill, Sonoma, California 2021 – *baking spices & apple pie, toasted hazelnut, vanilla custard, crème brûlée* 48
- Chardonnay, Stuhlmuller Vineyard, Alexander Valley, Sonoma, California, 2020 – *estate-bottled, stone fruit, vanilla, & pear, creamy & tropical, sustainable* 13 / 38 
- Chardonnay, Sixto Uncovered, Smith & Leighton, Washington 2019 – *stone fruit, apple, sea breeze & wildflowers, stone, almond, 19 months on lees in 25% new French oak, special* 60
- Fiano, Humble Roots, Australia 2019 – *fresh & zippy, tropical fruit, whiffs of wildflower honey, white flowers, citrus & melon, organic* 40
- Fume Blanc, Ferrari Carano, Sonoma, 2022 – *zesty tropical w/a hint of grassiness, creamy citrus* 11 / 34 
- Grüner Veltliner, Loess, Domäne Wachau, Austria, 2020 (1L) – *lively acidity & juiciness notes of pepper, herbaceous & fruity finish, hand harvested, sustainable certified* 40
- Pinot Grigio, Livon, Collio, Italy, 2021 – *fragrant bouquet, recalling vanilla and lime flowers, hand harvested* 13 / 40 
- Riesling, Boundary Breaks #239, Finger Lakes, 2021 – *honeysuckle, acacia notes to lemon & apple, estate grown, zingy!* 42
- Riesling, Schloss Gobelsburg, Schlosskellerei Kamptal Riesling, 2020 – *classic; peach and Gravenstein apple* 55
- Sancerre, Pierre Prieur et Fils, Domaine de Saint-Pierre, Sancerre, France, 2020 – *vivacious; white and citrus fruit aromas, fresh saline finish, organic, hand harvested* 60
- Sancerre, Joseph Mellot Bellecours, Loire Valley, France 2022 – *100% Sauv. Blanc, sweet floral aromas, rich & flinty, well balanced & dry* 70
- Sauvignon Blanc, Dashwood, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2021 – *Crisp & bright, gooseberry & citrus, lingering tropical fruit finish* 12 / 36 
- Sauvignon Blanc, Lighthouse, Benguela Cove, Walker Bay, South Africa 2021 – *yaaas! Goosberry, guava, & lemon, rose blossom notes, lingering fruit, great minerality, estate grown, ♀vintner* 36
- Vermentino, Argiolas, Sardegna Costamolino, Italy 2021 – *wow! wildflowers, stone fruit, citrus, savory & crisp, saline close* 12 / 36 
- Vinho Verde, Aveleda, Portugal 2021 – *what you expect: light, fizzy with accents of peaches and tropical fruits, refreshing* 10 / 30
- Vouvray, Gros Pierre, Domaine Florent Cosme, France 2021 – *Chenin Blanc, 45-yo vines, apple, citrus, spice, bright acidity, certified biodynamic, estate-bottled* 55
- Viognier, Art Den Hoed Vineyard, K Vintners, Yakima Valley, Washington 2021 – *fruit & flower bouquet, citrus zest, slate* 48

- Orange, Where's Linus, Shannon Ridge Vineyard, Lake County, California 2021- 100% Viognier, "it's own animal," unfiltered, aromatic, with a cool textural experience, organic, unique 48
- Rosé, Cistercien, Schloss Goebelsburg Schlosskellerei, Kamptal, Austria 2022 - Zweigelt and St. Laurent (70/30), wild cherry & fresh berries, charming! 38
- Barolo, Réva, La Morra, Italy 2017 - ripe black cherry, raspberry compote, licorice and baking spice accompanied by fine-grained velvety tannins 90
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Ultraviolet, Napa, California, 20 - a real sipper! velvety, fruit-driven, organic, ♀-vintner 12 / 38 
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Earthquake, Michael David Winery, Lodi, California, 212019 - intense, black cherry, licorice, tobacco, French oak 40
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Giapoza, California, 2019 - dark fruits & chocolate, star anise, espresso, toasted French oak 44
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Austin Hope, Paso Robles, California, 2020 - black cherry, burnt sugar, slight smoke leads to vanilla foam, dark fruit, roasted coffee & nuances of spice 70
- Cabernet Sauvignon, Stag's Leap, Napa, California, 2020 - the big kahuna, dazzling - red berry fruit, lavender, violet, & baking spice nose, juicy cassis, blackberry, and red cherry with hint of red rose, tobacco leaf, & forest dirt 105
- Cahors, Cèdre Heritage, 2019 - blackcurrant, wild pepper and mint, organic, delightful with food 42
- Chianti, Le Querce Seconda, Niccolo Bernabei, Montespertoli, Italy 2017 - 100% Sangiovese, notes of red fruit, currant, plum spice, and eucalyptus, well-balanced, hand-harvested, organic 64
- Malbec, Inkarrí, Lujan de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina 2020 - berry bomb, w/ cassis, chocolately, organic, estate bottled 12 / 38 
- Merlot, The Revivalist, Tortoise Creek, Clarksburg, California, 2020 - make an exception to your 'no f---ing merlot" rule 11 / 36 
- Pinot Noir, Fossil Point, Edna Valley, California 2019 - vibrant, black cherry, leather, vanilla, excellent depth, hand-harvested 48
- Pinot Noir, Underwood, Oregon, 2020 - it's everywhere b/c it's good, bub; plush tannins & bright acidity; juicy and spicy 11 / 33 
- Pinot Noir, Robert Sinskey, Carneros, California, 2017 - epic; berries & plum, lavender & sage, hints of warm spice 90
- Pinot Noir, SLH, Hahn Estate, Santa Lucia Highlands, California, 2021 - oh boy, oh boy, cherries, berries, vanilla, plums 65
- Petite Sirah, Grady Family Vineyards, Lodi, California 2019 - full-bodied & intense, dark plum, black cherry and blackberry with hints of vanilla on the finish 45
- Petite Sirah, Tower Road, J. Lohr Vineyard, Paso Robles, California 2019 - bright & energetic, cranberry, olallieberry & floral notes, concentrated & well-structured, 18-mos on French oak 70
- Red Blend, The Pessimist, Daou, California 2021 - no holds barred! intense aromas and flavors of berries & plum, with leather, tobacco, spice, & forest loam 40
- Red Blend - Zin/Cab/Petite Sirah/Syrah/Charbono, The Prisoner, California 2021 - unlikely mix of varietals=cult wine; raspberry, vanilla, and coconut leading to blackberry, pomegranate, and vanilla, wicked good 90
- Red Blend - Malbec/Merlot/Cab/Syrah/Petit Verdot/Cab Franc, Close de la Siete, Valle de Uco, Argentina, 2018 - intense & seductive; dark fruit, blackberries and blueberries, and floral notes accompanied by delicate hints of spice hand harvested, aged in new and old French oak, and in vats 14 / 42 
- Rosso Toscano, Solengo, Argiano, Montecino, Italy 2018 - Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Sangiovese, putting the SUPER in Tuscan! Organic too... 80
- Valpolicella Classico, Duca Fedele, Massimago, Veneto, Italy - Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara, classic structure, bright fruit, organic, ♀-vintner 70
- Zinfandel, Old Vines, Wild Thing, Carol Shelton, Mendocino County, California 2020 - treasure; 60+ yo vines, wild yeast, 14 mos in American oak, black cherry, plum, raspberry, hint of cigar, vanilla-oak baking spice, creamy w/jammy finish, ♀-vintner 50
